<p>4 New Position</p> <p>Mental Health Technician (MHT)</p> <p>Full-time</p> <p>Geriatric Psyche Unit (Opening 9-25-2017)</p>	<p>Mental health technicians (MHT) must have plenty of compassion and patience, the ability to handle stressful and demanding situations, and a deep level of concern for others. Good communication skills are essential, even when the other party is confused, upset, uncooperative, or irritable. This job requires observing skills, the ability to work independently and as a part of a team. The position also calls for dedication and dependability, as well as a certain degree of humility, since MHTs must be able to take orders, report to supervisors, & work on routine or even repetitive tasks daily. For a MHT to succeed, he or she must be able to put such services in perspective and focus on the greater positive effects they bring. MHTs answer patients' calls for assistance, obtain and record vital signs, and monitor behavior and physical condition for progress or deterioration. All MHTs work under the supervision of an experienced nurse, and report any problems or worsening in a patient's condition to the program staff. Monitor and observe clients' health status and physical care needs at admission and while clients are in the program. Assist clients in and out of the unit, to and from eating areas & restrooms. Functions as a member of the Interdisciplinary Treatment Team. Performs administrative, clerical, and other tasks according to program policy. Demonstrates professionalism in all aspects of performance. MHTs will be working with the mental health team---consisting of registered nurses, therapists, social workers, and psychiatrists. Participates in planning and implementing patient treatments. Minimum Requirements: Must have graduated and hold current Nursing Assistant certification from the state of Georgia and Current Basic Life Support (BLS) certification. Two years of acute hospital care or psychiatric unit experience preferred. Must obtain Crisis Prevention certification within 30 days of hire date.</p>
